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SUBJECT: Inventory of AT&T Remote Terminal Equipment

This bulletin is to inform CALNET 2 customers that AT&T has subcontracted with APEX CoVantage to conduct an inventory of AT&T's remote terminals. The inventory is currently underway and is expected to be completed by August 31, 2008.

AT&T owned remote terminals are considered central office remotes usually connected by fiber for the purpose of providing dial tone or high-cap data services to CALNET customers. This equipment is typically located at the minimum point of entry (MPOE), usually on the 1st floor or basement.

The inventory conducted by APEX CoVantage will include Global Positioning System readings and digital photographs at each location.

APEX CoVantage will only require access into agency buildings and areas where the remote terminal equipment is housed. All subcontractors will have a current AT&T Contractor ID badge, an ID badge from their respective subcontracting company, as well as a sign on the side of the vehicle identifying the name of the subcontracting company.

APEX CoVantage will not provide prior notification of arrival.
