TA 16-13: CalCloud Network Attached Storage

Overview:

The California Department of Technology (CDT) began offering CalCloud services to its customers in the summer of 2014. Since then, CDT has introduced many additional CalCloud service offerings.

New Service:

Network Attached Storage (NAS) is now available to all CalCloud laaS customers through the CalCloud portal. The NAS service offering provides the capability for file sharing between VMs within a tenant's environment using either Common Internet File System (CIFS) or Network File System (NFS) v4. CalCloud NAS can be provisioned using either Tier 2 or Tier 3 storage with the applicable <u>rate</u>.

Customers interested in the new CalCloud NAS service must first acquire CalCloud tenant space to access the self-service portal. The NAS service is only available to servers within the tenant's CalCloud environment unless a Virtual Routing and Forwarding or Virtual Private Network (VPN) is used to provide external access which requires a separate monthly VPN charge.
