- Cost effective consistency in testing methodology and reporting

- Expect a response within 5 business days
- State IT Specialist oversees full service
- 9 Inmate hires perform testing and reporting

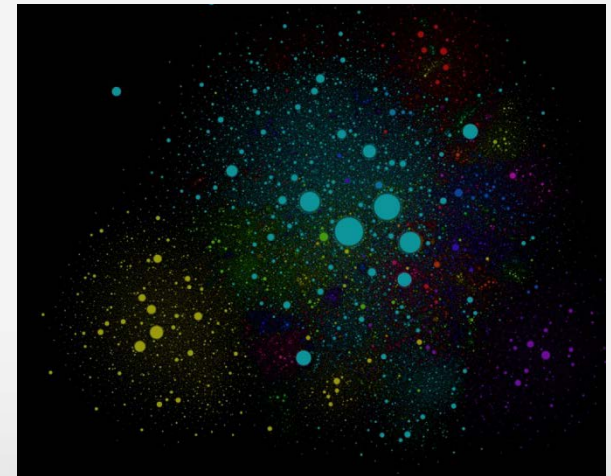

- Get online - Accessibility Compliance Testing Service Request

- Submit your request for service
- Receive your response (Invoice or notification of non-acceptance)
- Send in a P.O. and away we go
- Once the report of findings is complete, it is sent to your CIO\AIO, and the head of your Agency, Department, Commission, or Board.
