Cloud Assessment

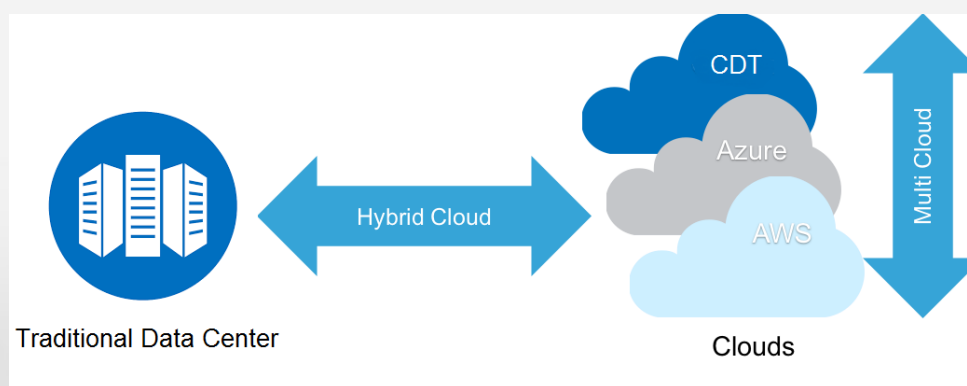
A cloud assessment is the first step to cloud migration. It determines a business's readiness for the cloud and provides a business strategy to get there.





Operational Strategy

- Extend
 - Connect existing environment/network to the cloud
- Duplicate (standalone)
 - Create similar services in the cloud
- Hybrid
 - Combination of extending and duplicating services





Cloud Migration Strategies

	Time	Cost	Agility
Retain: Leave it alone	+	\$	N/A
Retire: Decommission	++	\$	N/A
Re-host: Lift-and-shift the application	++	\$\$	**
Re-platform (Rebuild): Lift-tinker-and-shift (light modifications the application)	+++	\$\$\$	***
Re-Design: (Replace or Repurchase): Rebuild to take advantage of cloud-native features	+++	\$\$\$	***
Refactor: Re-development to take advantage of cloud-native features	++++	\$\$\$\$	****

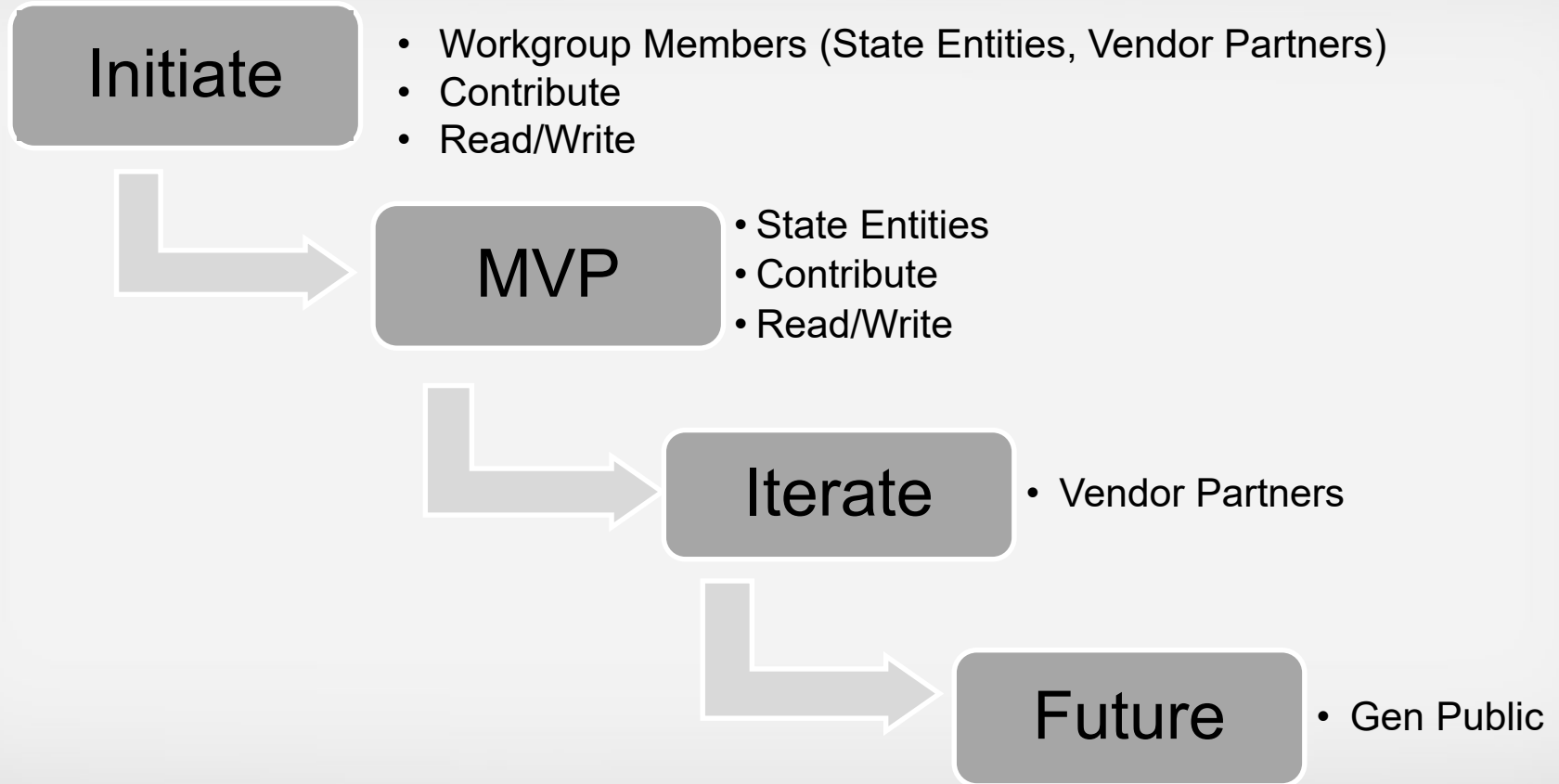
