The CIO acknowledges the following Information Technology Leadership Academy (ITLA) expectations:	
 Requires a 18-week commitment from January 7, 2026 – May 6, 2026. Incurs a cost of \$5,400 per candidate, and there are no refunds once the academy begins. Requires full participation in the formal training sessions with no more than three (3) absences. Involves a significant time commitment which will require the redistribution of the candidate's workload due to the combination of scheduled sessions and tasks/assignments to be completed outside of class (e.g., preparation for the CIO Academy, Walk Like a Leader, Team Class Exercise, etc.). Will be conducted via both remote and in-person platforms. In-person sessions will be delivered at the Department of Technology's TEC and students will be expected to attend regardless of their location. It is also important to note that in-person sessions are not offered via hybrid, are not recorded, and cannot be made up at a later date. May incur travel costs associated with this academy (e.g., travel to the TEC for in-person sessions). If the CIO's candidate is accepted and graduates, the CIO commits to providing at least three distinct, high-value opportunities for the graduate to see strong leadership in action within six months of his/her graduation. (Examples could be attending a legislative or budget hearing, shadowing a meeting that models strategic thinking and data-driven decision making, and/or providing exposure to opportunities within the executive community.
